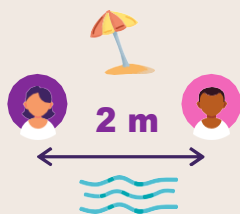
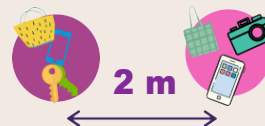


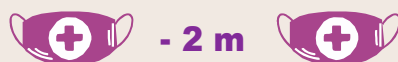
## RULES ON THE USE OF BEACHES DUE TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS ISSUED BY BEACH STAFF.

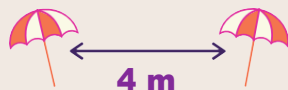


WEAR YOUR FACE MASK IF YOU CANNOT KEEP THE SAFETY DISTANCE.

THE USE OF INFLATABLES IS NOT ALLOWED.



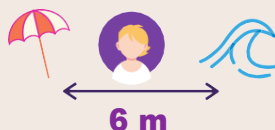
GROUP SPORTS ARE NOT ALLOWED.

SHARED FACILITY: BE CONSIDERATE TO OTHER USERS WHO ARE WAITING.



A 6-METRE-WIDE STRIP MUST BE KEPT FREE AT THE SHORELINE TO ENABLE PEOPLE TO COME AND GO.



USE THE LITTERBINS. DO NOT LEAVE LITTER ON THE SAND OR IN THE WATER.
